3. Attend the following team meetings:
 - a. Team Meeting 1: (August 7, 2010, 2:00P.M. to 6:00 P.M.)
 - b. Team Meeting 2: (September 11, 2010, 2:00P.M. to 6:00 P.M.)
 - c. Team Meeting 3: (September 25, 2010, 2:00P.M. to 6:00 P.M.)
 - d. Team Grounding: (October 2, 2010, 2:00P.M. to 6:00 P.M.)
 - e. Room Set-up/Grounding: (October 14, 2010, 6:00P.M.)
 - f. Man Talk: (October 15 at 8:00A.M. to October 17 at 7:00 P.M.)
4. Participate in regular team coaching calls (every other week, day and time to be set up at Team Meeting 1).
5. Enroll and register participants into *Man Talk*.
6. Pray for *Man Talk* and do what it takes to accomplish the vision of having a powerful, God-honoring training.
